They are able to offer primary care services on a sliding fee scale to make health care both accessible and affordable to everyone who walks through the doors. Sweetwater Health Center and Pharmacy currently offers primary care, pharmacy and lab services.

Sweetwater Health Center and Pharmacy plans to add dental services for its patients this year. In 2014, a local dentist donated two chairs to the health center. They plan on offering cleanings, extractions and fillings for both adults and children starting in March.
